## Setup and Takedown of Goals Guidelines

## Set up:

- If you are the first game of the day arrive early and set up the goals for your field.
- The goals and black rolling boxes will be setting outside the connex box by the snack bar
- When setting up the goals, there are stakes in the black age group box that are to be used on the metal of the goals.
- The stakes are not for the nets.
- There are 4 stakes for each goal. One for the front and rear of each of the side goal triangles. These are a must.
- The stakes are very important. There are accidents that involve goals being pulled over and the weight of the goal crashing down on can injure players, coaches and bystanders.


## Take down:

- If you are the last game of your age group of the day break down your goals and take them to the connex box; the goal post materials can be leaned against the connex box.
- Place the nets back in the red bags inside the black age group box.
- Be sure to gather the stakes and put them in the black age group box.
- Don't forget the corner flags.
- Clean up the field of any trash or debris
