Coaches Checklist

- Call players as soon as rosters are provided
- When you get your team, get your sponsor as soon as possible, this helps with timely uniforms
- Coaches are responsible for providing practice equipment (balls, cones, etc.) It is strongly recommended to have each player bring their own ball and several cones to each practice.
- If you do not have an assistant coach by the time you start practices choose one at your first practice, along with team mom/dad.
- All games are played at Riverbend Park
- Team banners to be completed before Opening Day (U4, U6, U8, U10 girls)
- Hand out regular season schedules once they are posted or given to you by your age group director
- Email your age group director for any questions. Emails provided at www.oroillyouthsoccer.com under Contacts.

Coaches Field Responsibilities

- First game's coach set-up nets, flags and field equipment. These are kept in the black 'tote' boxes in or by the storage container.
- Pick up trash with your team after your game.
- Last game's coaches return nets, flags, field equipment and game ball to the black 'tote' box and put away at the storage container. The older division's game balls are kept by the ref's.
